### **Fracking causes immediate and lasting harm:**

- Permanent contamination of the town's well water, increased radon and fracking chemical vapor exposure.
- Serious health hazards including birth defects, severe asthma, skin lesions, low birthweight babies, and cancers
- Lower property values on land that relies on well water.
- Major damage to our narrow, local roads.
- Noxious odors, pounding noise, burdens on emergency responders, and leaking bore holes long after wells are abandoned— with all costs borne by local taxpayers
